The contest is open to the West Point Community.

Submit your individual pattern design, your organization's design, or your team's pattern design for the **FREEDOM FIGHTERS MEMORIAL QUILT.**

### What is the **FREEDOM FIGHTERS MEMORIAL QUILT?**

The Freedom Fighters Memorial Quilt is a worldwide initiative designed to remember those service members who have given their lives in the War on Terrorism in Iraq, Afghanistan and other hot spots around the world. West Point plans to participate in this program by hosting a contest and submitting the winning West Point Quilt.

### Contest Details

- Contest is open to the West Point Community.
- Quilt pattern designs must be submitted no later than **November 30, 2004.**
- Submit quilt pattern designs to West Point Multi Crafts, building 648, Mills Road
- The winning quilt design will be selected as the West Point quilt for inclusion in the **FREEDOM FIGHTERS MEMORIAL QUILT** program.

### Quilt Pattern Design Specifications - *Quilts must include the following details:*

- Completed quilt can be no more, or no less than 40" X 70"
- Please leave a block of space open for the name of a deceased military service member
- Installation name: West Point, New York
- The remainder of the quilt design is left to your discretion
- Paints, collages, and stencils are all acceptable forms of pattern design

### Judging of Pattern Designs

Submissions will be accepted until November 30, 2004. A select panel will determine, by unanimous vote, which design will be used for the West Point quilt. Judging will take place on or about December 06, 2004.

### I submitted the winning design – who makes the quilt?

A group of volunteer quilters from West Point will begin assembling and sewing the quilt. If you wish to participate in making the quilt, please contact Multi Crafts.
