1. SITUATION. See base OPORD.

2. MISSION. The Advanced Land Navigation Committee trains Third Class Cadets in the northern training areas from 25 June to 7 July 2004 in order to certify select pre-commissioning tasks and to improve Cadet land navigation abilities.

3. EXECUTION.

Intent: The purpose is to certify Third Class Cadets on seven pre-commissioning tasks (PCT) and to improve their land navigation abilities. Key tasks include: leader certification, PCT training, advanced land navigation technique training, management of training resources, and mitigating unnecessary risks. By the end of this training event, Cadets will be proficient in the seven pre-commissioning tasks and more confident in their land navigation abilities.

a. Concept of operations. We will accomplish this training in three phases: set-up, leader training program (LTP), and execution. First, our Committee will establish the site and certify all trainers. Second, the Committee will train and certify the cadet chain of command during the LTP. Training will include the seven pre-commissioning tasks, tactical movement, linkup operations, patrol base activities, and a refresher on troop leading procedures. The cadet chain of command will conduct a practical exercise to demonstrate proficiency. Finally, the Committee trains and certifies the Third Class Cadets during the execution phase. In a base camp setting, the Committee will train Cadets on the seven pre-commissioning tasks, advanced land navigation techniques, and squad movement formations. The Cadets will practice these skills during a scenario-driven lane training exercise. (See TAB A and B.)
