1. SITUATION. Each New Cadet Company will execute the Warrior Competition as part of the physical program in order to develop squad cohesiveness and teamwork through physical competition.

2. MISSION. Cadet Summer Training Warrior Competition Committee executes a squad-level physically challenging competition for United States Military Academy new cadets from 5-8, 12-14 and 16 July 2004 at West Point, NY to develop squad cohesiveness and teamwork, provide leadership opportunities for First and Second Class cadets, and to inspire all cadets to stay physically fit in order to meet the physical demands of our Army.

3. EXECUTION. Intent. I expect New Cadets to develop squad-level cohesiveness, enhance leadership, and build teamwork through a challenging series of physically demanding events. Each cadet will realize success through hard work and teamwork.

a. Concept of Operation. The Warrior Competition OIC and cadet chain of command are responsible for the training and administration of eight cadet companies of approximately 140 cadets on the Warrior Competition, a series of physically demanding collective tasks designed as a squad-level competition. One company per day will conduct training. Cadet company training dates are 5-8, 12-14, and 16 July 2004. The cadet cadre will participate in a Leaders Training Program (LTP) of all 8 companies for two hours on 26 June. Focus of LTP is on cadet cadre. During LTP, each cadet cadre member will certify on the event they are to supervise and grade.


